SCHOOL PUNCTUALITY TARGET

We have set ourselves a challenging punctuality target for this half term of no more than 55 'lates' for the whole half term. With only 3 weeks of the half term to go, we already have 30 lates recorded—at that rate we will not hit our target! We record children as being late to school if they come in through the main entrance after their usual entrance doors have been closed. Doors open at 8.45am each day and children should be ready to come into school at that time.

Parents are asked to help us achieve this target by ensuring children arrive at school on time every day.



PRINTING MATHLETICS CERTIFICATES

We are really impressed with how many of the children in school are achieving Mathletics certificates every week and are finding ourselves printing hundreds of coloured certificates every month. In order to help us cut printing costs we have decided that we will only routinely print Mathletics certificates for the child in each class with the highest points total and any gold awards from now on. Children are still able to view all of their certificates in the 'My Certificates' section of Mathletics and these can also be downloaded and printed at home. The Mathletics website also allows children to see how many certificates they earned in previous years so they can set themselves challenges! We feel this is a much more efficient to store certificates but will, of course, be happy to print a certificate if a child asks.

SWIMMING CONTRIBUTION REMINDER

We are really proud of the fact that nearly every one of our children is able to swim 25m by the time they leave Amble Links. We feel this is extremely important as we live so close to the river and the sea. Although we already subsidise them from the school budget, we are only able to provide swimming lessons for all children from half way through their Reception year with contributions towards lessons from parents..

Our children have a 1 hour swimming lesson every other week and we ask for a contribution of £4 per lesson (or £2 per lesson if the child is entitled to Pupil Premium). Please send contributions to the school office.

Swimming lessons for next week are for **Year 2 on Thursday** and **Year 4 on Friday**. Please ensure children come to school with their swimming kit. We ask for a contribution of £4 per lesson (children have 1hr lessons every other week) or £2 if your child is entitled to Pupil Premium.
