Y3 LEXIA & Y4 TOUCH TYPE READ SPELL

From September, we have encouraged our Y3 and Y4 children to arrive at school at 8.30am daily to complete online tasks using Lexia (Y3) and TTRS (Y4). We have invested heavily in staffing and resources to provide this. We are very pleased to see that the vast majority of Y3 and Y4 children arriving at school at 8,30am and are now beginning to see some very good progress being made by the children, especially those arriving early every day. All of this extra daily practice totals more than an hour per week for children and is developing their confidence and fluency in literacy (Y3) and touch typing/spelling (Y4). Parents are encouraged to ensure that children in Y3 and Y4 arrive at school at 8.30am daily-it really is making a difference!

Along with our weekly number draw in assembly, parents are reminded that we also run an ongoing school lottery through 'Your School Lottery'. There is a guaranteed weekly prize which increases when we sell more tickets as well as the chance to win £25,000. Any tickets that you buy help raise funds for our PTA which then goes to support the work of the school in many different ways.
