NEW SCHOOL DINNER OPTIONS LAUNCHED

This week we have launched our new school dinner options with our summer menu. During Wednesday's assembly Miss Lightley and Mr Heeley demonstrated how quickly and easily a healthy pasta meal could be created in a 'Ready Steady Cook' style. At lunchtime all children were given the opportunity to try 2 of our 3 new pasta dishes ; these seemed to go down very well indeed. From Monday, on 3 days per week, children will also have a pasta option to choose from. These are:
